

STUDIO POLICY
SPRING 2021
Columbia Music Lessons

TUITION: Each student is enrolled for 20 private lessons during the Spring Semester. Lessons are divided up across the 5-month time frame from January 1, 2020 through May 31, 2020. Tuition for a 30-minute (weekly) lesson is \$375.00 for the entire Spring Semester, and likewise tuition for a 60-minute (weekly) lessons is \$750.00 for the entire semester. This may be paid in full at the beginning of the semester or divided into 5 equal monthly payments of either \$75 or \$150. Payment can be made by cash, check, money order, PayPal, or credit card and are due by the 7th day of each month. Lessons will continue beginning the week of January 1st, 2020. At that time I will issue a new policy and calendar for the Summer semester. Please realize that the number of lessons per month does not affect the monthly installment, as it is based on the total lessons averaged over the 5-month period. One month you may be scheduled for five lessons whereas in another month you may have only three. Again, your payments are based on the total number of lessons during the semester, not the number of lessons per month. A Late Fee of \$10.00 will be added after the second lesson should you forget.

ATTENDANCE: Since tuition is based on enrollment, not attendance, I cannot give refunds or credits. The only exception being if I must miss a lesson, I will make it up, or credit your account for the following month. Please arrange for siblings to stay home and/or keep out of the student's lesson space unless they can sit quietly. However, my studio is open to anyone who is a polite listener. No gum, please!

TERMINATION: Should a student decide to discontinue lessons, notice must be given before the 1st of the month and full payment is due for the month in which termination occurs.

By enrolling yourself or your child(ren) and by making your first month's tuition payment, you acknowledge that you understand and agree to the above studio terms. I look forward to working with you as we strive to make music a lifelong companion for you and your child.
